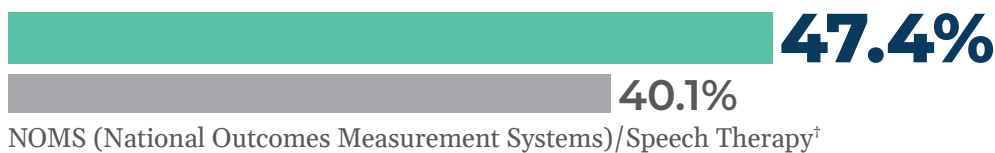
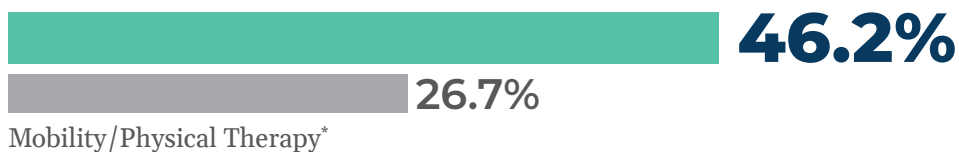


# Industry-Leading Therapy Outcomes
